Our Safety policy shall incorporate all the principles of Quality Management to assure consistency and realistic continual improvement. We shall strive for excellence in safety for all integrated operations and shall ensure all personnel are consulted and included in our policy.

This policy will be regularly monitored to ensure that objectives are achieved. It will be reviewed and, if necessary, revised in the light of legislative or organisational changes.

Ainscough Industrial Services are committed to the development of culture based Health and Safety and will continue to develop this through the forthcoming year with both employees and those organisations providing support to the Group.

This Policy applies to all sites, premises and undertakings of Ainscough Industrial Services and includes all recent and planned future acquisitions and developments in 2018.
